ORDINANCE OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBE RESCINDING ALL ORDINANCES ALLOWING TRIBAL COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES TO USE FUNDS FROM THEIR BUDGETED TRAVEL LINE ITEMS OR FUNDS FROM THEIR FEDERAL MONITORS FOR TRIBAL DISTRICT PURPOSES, INCLUDING ORDINANCE NOS. 19-32 AND 19-50.

WHEREAS, the Oglala Sioux Tribe adopted its Constitution and By-Laws by referendum vote on December 14, 1935, in accordance with Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 (25 U.S.C. § 5123) and under Article III of the Oglala Sioux Tribe Constitution, the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oglala Sioux Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Constitution, in Article IV, Section 1(f), vests the Tribal Council with the authority to manage all economic affairs of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, in the exercise of this and other authorities, the Tribal Council enacted Ordinance No. 19-32 (Jul. 11, 2019) to establish a Tribal Council Travel Budget Line Item Use for District Purposes Policy, and thereafter, the Tribal Council enacted and Ordinance No. 19-50 (Oct. 31, 2019) to amend that policy, and

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2021, the Finance Committee of the Tribal Council approved a motion to rescind all ordinances allowing Tribal Council Representatives to use funds from their budgeted travel line items for assistance and other purposes for their Tribal Districts, including Ordinance No. 19-32 and Ordinance No. 19-50, which allowed Tribal Council Representatives to use the budgeted line items of their Federal Monitors for assistance and other purposes for their Districts, and

WHEREAS, having considered the matter, the Tribal Council enacts this Ordinance to rescind all ordinances allowing Tribal Council Representatives to use funds from their budgeted travel line items or funds from their Federal Monitors for assistance and other purposes for their Tribal Districts, including Ordinance Nos. 19-32 and 19-50; now


THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council hereby rescinds all ordinances allowing Tribal Council Representatives to use funds from their budgeted travel line items for assistance and other purposes for their Tribal Districts, including Ordinance No. 19-32 (Jul. 11, 2019) and Ordinance No. 19-50 (Oct. 31, 2019), which allowed Tribal Council Representatives to use the budgeted line items of their Federal Monitors for assistance and other purposes for their Districts, and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately and shall supersede all prior inconsistent laws of the Tribe.
