ORDINANCE OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBE  
AMENDING ORDINANCE 19-22 TO CREATE THE YOUTH AFFAIRS COMMITTEE AS A  
STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Oglala Sioux Tribe adopted its Constitution and By-Laws by referendum vote on December 14, 1935, in accordance with Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 (25 U.S.C. § 5123) and under Article III of the Oglala Sioux Tribe Constitution, the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oglala Sioux Tribe, and

WHEREAS, under Article IV, Section 1(u) of the Constitution, the Tribal Council has the authority "to adopt ordinances regulating the procedure of the council itself," and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has exercised this authority to establish six (6) Standing Committees of the Tribal Council to assist in the governance of the Oglala Sioux Tribe by Ordinance Nos. 19-22, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council called a special Tribal Council meeting to create a space for youth members of the Tribe to voice their comments and concerns to the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, at the Special Tribal Council meeting held on February 20, 2021, the Tribal Council approved a motion to create a Youth Affairs Committee of the Tribal Council to serve as a liaison between the Tribal Council and the various youth committees throughout the Reservation; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council hereby authorizes and approves the creation of a Youth Affairs Committee as a Standing Committee of the Tribal Council to serve as a liaison between the Tribal Council and the various youth committees throughout the Reservation, and

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council hereby amends Section 1 and Section of Ordinance 19-22 (May 29, 2019), the Standing Committee Ordinance of 2019, to read as follows (with deletions in strikethrough and additions underlined and in bold):

**Section 1. Standing Committees Established.**

There shall be ~~six (6)~~ **seven (7)** Standing Committees of the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council. These committees are:

1. Finance;
2. Education;
3. Land;

4. Economic and Business Development;
5. Health and Human Services; and
6. Law and Order.

**7. Youth Affairs.**

**Section 2. Meeting Days and Notice.**


A. Regular meetings. The regular meeting days of the Standing Committees shall be as follows:

1. Monday - Education; Land
2. Tuesday - Health and Human Services
3. Wednesday - Judiciary; **Youth Affairs Committee**
4. Thursday - Finance
5. Friday - Economic and Business Development


