RESOLUTION OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBE AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ), OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS (OJP), OFFICE OF SEX OFFENDER SENTENCING, MONITORING, APPREHENDING, REGISTERING AND TRACKING (SMART), FOR FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$400,000 FROM THE SMART FY21 SUPPORT FOR ADAM WALSH ACT IMPLEMENTATION GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Oglala Sioux Tribe adopted its Constitution and By-Laws by referendum vote on December 14, 1935, in accordance with Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 (25 U.S.C. § 5123) and under Article III of the Oglala Sioux Tribe Constitution, the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oglala Sioux Tribe, and

WHEREAS, under Article IV, Sections 1(f) and 1(w), of the Tribal Constitution, the Tribal Council has the authority to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe and to adopt laws protecting and promoting the health and general welfare of the Tribe and its members, and

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2021, the Law and Order Committee passed a motion to authorize the submission of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Office of Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering and Tracking (SMART) for funding in the amount of \$400,000 from the SMART FY21 Support for Adam Walsh Act Implementation Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, grant funding will be used to pay the salaries of the Tribe's Sex Offender Compliance Officers for three years and may also be used for public education and training; now


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Oglala Sioux Tribe and the Oglala Sioux Tribe Department of Public Safety (OSTDPS) to submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Office of Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering and Tracking (SMART) for funding in the amount of \$400,000 from the SMART FY21 Support for Adam Walsh Act Implementation Grant Program, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes and directs the Tribal President or, in his absence, the Tribal Vice-President to execute any necessary grant application documents on behalf of the Tribe.
