RESOLUTION OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBE APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ) FOR FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$900,000 FROM THE BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE (BJA) THROUGH THE COORDINATED TRIBAL ASSISTANCE SOLICITATION (CTAS) FOR PURPOSE AREA 3 (TRIBAL JUSTICE SYSTEMS PROGRAM) TO ALLOW THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBAL COURT TO HIRE ONE (1) PUBLIC DEFENDER AND TWO (2) PROBATION OFFICERS FOR FIVE (5) YEARS.

WHEREAS, the Oglala Sioux Tribe adopted its Constitution and By-laws by referendum vote on December 14, 1935, in accordance with Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, and under Article III of the Oglala Sioux Tribe Constitution, the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oglala Sioux Tribe, and

WHEREAS, under Article IV, Sections 1(f) and 1(w), of the Tribal Constitution, the Tribal Council has the authority to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe and to adopt laws protecting and promoting the health and general welfare of the Tribe and its members, and

WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee of the Tribal Council approved a motion to authorize the submission of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) for funding in the amount of \$900,000 from the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) through the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation (CTAS) for Purpose Area 3 (Tribal Justice Systems Program) to allow the Oglala Sioux Tribal Court to hire one (1) public defender and two (2) probation officers (one at the Pine Ridge Courthouse and one at the Kyle Courthouse) for five (5) years; now


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council hereby authorizes the submission of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) for funding in the amount of \$900,000 from the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) through the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation (CTAS) for Purpose Area 3 (Tribal Justice Systems Program) to allow the Oglala Sioux Tribal Court to hire one (1) public defender and two (2) probation officers (one at the Pine Ridge Courthouse and one at the Kyle Courthouse) for five (5) years, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal President or, in his absence, the Tribal Vice-President to execute any and all documents necessary for submission of the grant application.


